

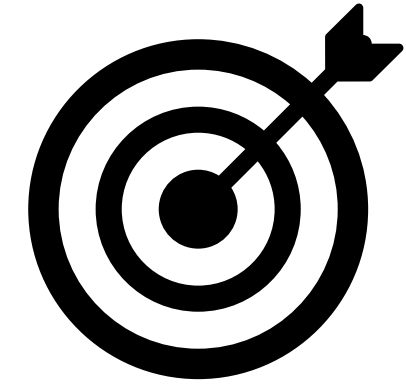

Define your purpose

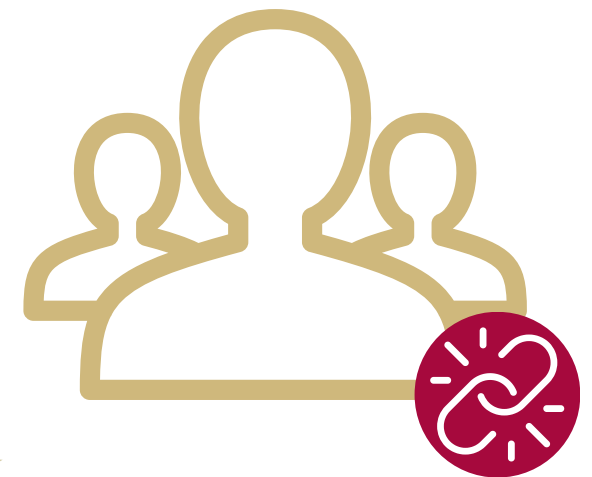
Defining your purpose as a student org cultivates a sense of direction, unity, and shared commitment among members, fostering a more impactful and meaningful collective experience on campus.

Find your officers and advisor

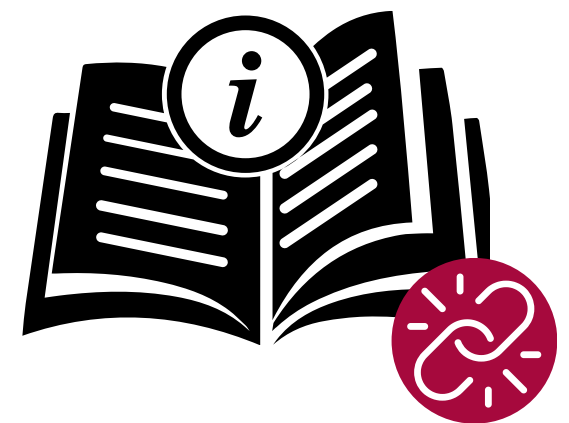
Each organization (excluding meet-up groups) is required to have a staff or faculty advisor (NOT A FELLOW STUDENT), president, vice president, and treasurer listed in the roster.

Read the manual

Gain a comprehensive understanding of the expectations, limitations, and resources available to make your organization as successful as possible.

Write the constitution

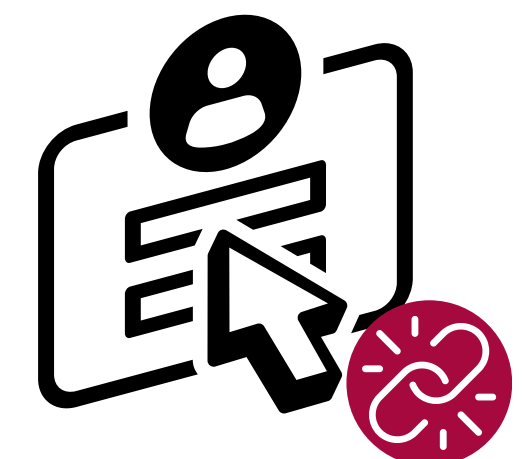
Next, create a constitution for your organization that outlines your purpose, how officers are elected or removed, etc. There is a sample for you to look review or use.

Submit the registration
